

Weekly Broiler Report

Settings for broiler production in the Keystone state during the week totaled 1,233,000 according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service. This was slightly less than the previous week and 8 per cent above a year ago.

The three week total was 5 per cent above the comparable period last year. Placements of chicks for commercial broiler production were 9 per cent below the previous week but 10 per cent above a year ago. The 10 week total was 5 per cent below a year ago.

Inshipments of broiler type chicks for the past 10 weeks totaled 629,000 or 49 per cent above last year. Outshipments of 1,217,000 were down 39 per cent.

Settings in the 22 major producing states totaled 60,578,000 eggs about the same as the previous week but 2 per cent above the previous year. The three week total remained the same as a year earlier. Placements declined 1 per cent from last week but was the same as last year. The 10 week total was the same as last year.

• Delmarva Prices Gain; Demand Is Good

Live broiler prices in Delmarva continued to increase more than a quarter cent during the 24 hours period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Demand was good for the moderate auction offerings.

Ready to cook demand was good with many plants running at capacity. Estimated slaughter for the week end by eastern shore processors was 982,000 head compared to the 831,000 head last week end.

Prices at farms ranged 147 to 157 for reported purchases of 826,000 head including 509,000 head purchased at Thursday's auction in Selbyville, Del. The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending June 5 was down one point from the previous week at 2.9. Broilers during the week averaged 14.61 per pound and mash cost the grower \$100.17 per ton.

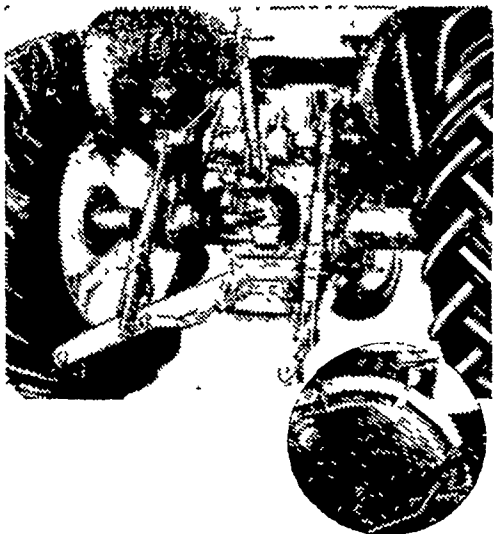
