

## Pest Control Short Course Set At PSU

Training in pest control work is available in a new two year winter course offered by the College of Agriculture at The Pennsylvania State University. The two year technical course was developed with the advice and financial support of the Pennsylvania and the National Pest Control Associations.

Fred E. Snyder, director of agricultural short courses at Penn State, says the training will prepare men and women for employment in the production, formulation, sale, and use of pesticides and in control work related to insects and other pests. He describes the training as the only two year winter course of its type in the United States.

The first year's instruction begins October 14 with the first term ending December 12 and the second term beginning January 13 and ending March 13. A six months on-the-job training runs from April through September. The second year's program starts in October.

Dr. Snyder says there is room for 17 more persons to enroll for classes starting in October. Laboratory facilities will accommodate 28 trainees.

Persons interested in enrolling should request an application form from Short Course Director, Room 211 Armsby Building, University Park, Pa. 16802. Details will be furnished regarding housing, food service, tuition fees, and other costs.

Instruction at the University Park campus will stress entomology, pesticide technology, control of pests, types and uses of spray equipment — and basic chemistry, botany, zoology and microbiology.

This training, Dr. Snyder says, will be supplemented with courses on soils and fertilizers, weed control, plant pathology, and turf management. Courses in written and spoken communication, business records, salesmanship, and personnel management prepare students for responsible positions. Dr. Snyder adds:

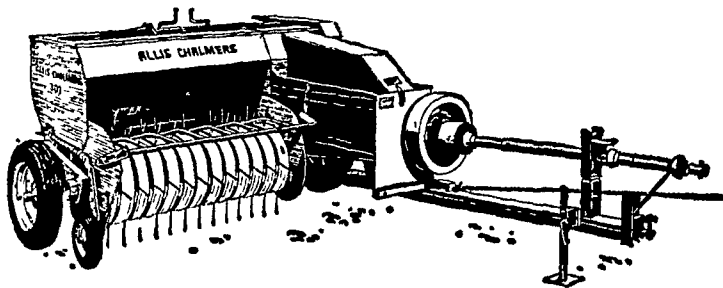

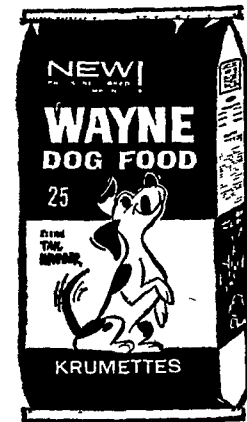
