SPENCE

- HAM LOAF**
25 Portions
- 2 pounds ground smoked ham (1aw)
 - 12 ounces ground fresh pork (1aw)
 - 12 ounces ground beef (1aw)
 - 6 ounces (1½ cups) celery, chopped
 - 1 ounce (2 tablespoons) fat or oil
 - ¾ cup (1) eggs
 - 3 cups cooked tomatoes
 - 1½ teaspoons salt
 - ¼ teaspoon pepper
 - ¾ teaspoon powdered dry mustard
 - 6 ounces (1½ cups) bread-crumbs dry

Combine ham, fresh pork and beef. Sauté celery in fat or oil for 10 minutes and add to meat mixture. Beat eggs and add to the meat mixture. Add tomatoes, seasonings and breadcrumbs. Mix thoroughly. Pack mixture into loaf pans (10 x 4 x 4 inches), about 3 pounds or 1½ quarts per pan. Bake at 400 degrees (hot) for 1½ hours. Double recipe for 50 portions.

BAKED FRANKFURTERS AND RICE

- 2 pounds 4 ounces frankfurters cut in ½ inch slices
- 1½ quarts cooked tomatoes
- 5 ounces (1 cup) green pepper, chopped
- 12 ounces (2 cups) onion, chopped

- 1 teaspoon garlic, minced
 - 1 pound 2 ounces (4½ cups) cheese, grated
 - 3 pounds cooked rice (2 quarts)
 - 2 teaspoons salt
- Combine all ingredients. Pour into greased baking pans (20½ by 12½ by 2½ inches), about 10 pounds 10 ounces or 1¼ gallons per pan. Cover and bake at 400 degrees (hot) for 50 minutes. Uncover and bake 15 minutes longer or until green pepper and onion are tender. Makes 25 portions (¾ cup). For 50 portions, double recipe.

BARBECUED LIMA BEANS

- 1 pound 12 ounces (1 quart) dry lima beans, (small)
- 3 quarts boiling water
- 6 ounces (1 cup) onion, chopped
- ¼ teaspoon garlic, minced
- 8 ounces salt pork, chopped
- 3 tablespoons prepared mustard
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- 2 teaspoons chili powder
- 2½ cups condensed tomato soup
- ¼ cup vinegar
- 1½ tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 cups bean liquid

Add beans to boiling water and boil for 2 minutes. Remove from heat cover and soak for 1 hour or overnight if more convenient. Boil gently until tender. Drain. Save the liquid. Brown onion and garlic with the salt pork. Combine all ingredients. Place mixture in baking pans (16 x 10½ by 2½ inches) about 7 pounds ½ ounces or 3¼ quarts per pan. Bake at 400 degrees (hot) for 30 minutes. Makes 25 portions (½ cup). For 50 portions (Continued on Page 7)

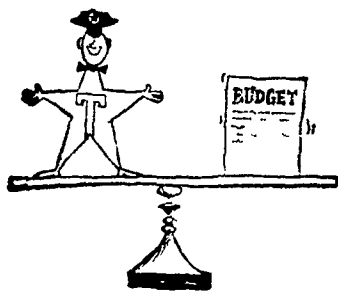

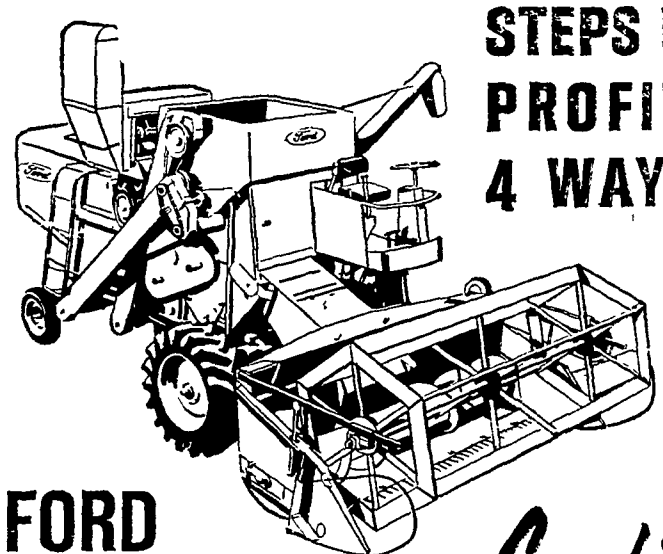
