Twenty Acres In Five Hours

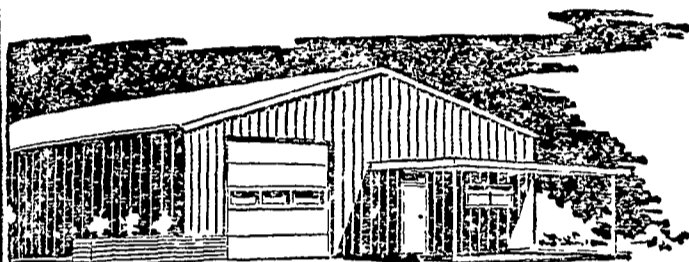
