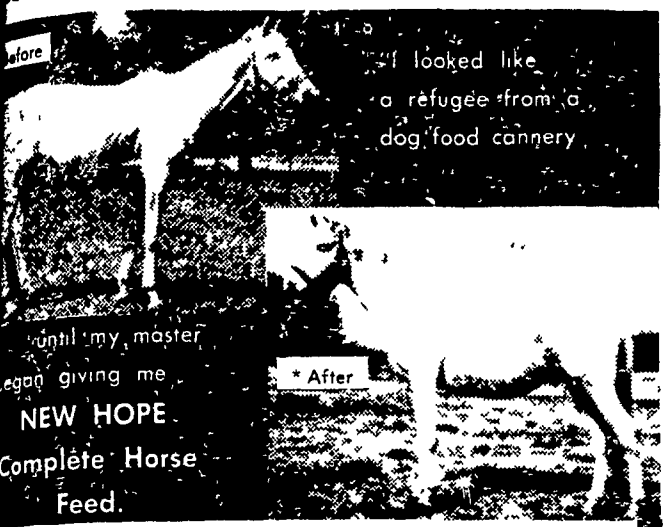
Society 18 will have the devotions at the Lancaster County Farm Women's Convention to be held on November 7, 1964 at the Solanco Area High School.
