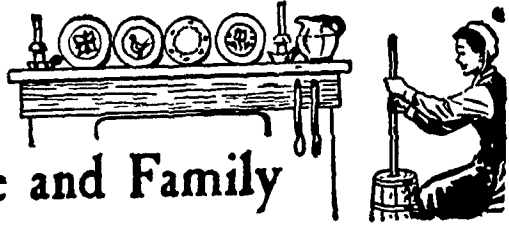

Fresh Fruits Of Summer

Now, when fresh fruits are in such abundance, is the time to try all those delicious desserts which you've been putting off till the fruits are "in season". Blueberries will be in till August — their tart flavor adds so much to a dessert. Peaches and pears will be in season soon as will the new apple crop. Fresh pineapples can be had most of the summer. Use these fruits often when they are cheapest; use them in a variety of ways and your family will never tire of them.

A "peachy-keen" dessert is Peach-Pear Pie A La Mode. It's made with fresh peaches and pears, which blend their sweet, sun-ripened flavors into one delectable filling.

Top it off with a scoop of peach ice cream to accent that fruity goodness.

PEACH-PEAR PIE

- Pastry for double-crust 9-inch pie
- 2 cups peeled and sliced fresh peaches
- 2 cups peeled and sliced fresh pears
- 1½ tablespoons tapioca
- ¾ cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons butter
- Peach ice cream

Prepare pastry and line pie plate. In a mixing bowl toss together sliced peaches, sliced pears, tapioca and sugar, pour into pastry lined pie plate. Dot with butter and cover with top crust. Form a high rim to retain juices during baking. Bake 50-60 minutes in a

375 degree oven. Serve slightly warm and topped with peach ice cream.

Another delightful dessert is Blueberry Funny Cake. A tasty cake is baked right into a pie, with built-in blueberry sauce to give it zest.

BLUEBERRY FUNNY CAKE

- 1 unbaked pie shell, 9-in.
- BLUEBERRY SAUCE:
 - 2 cups fresh blueberries
 - 1 cup sugar
 - 1 tablespoon water
 - 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- CAKE:
 - ¼ cup (½ stick) butter
 - ¾ cup sugar
 - 1 egg
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla
 - 1½ cups sifted cake flour
 - 1 teaspoon baking powder
 - ½ teaspoon salt

½ cup milk
In preparing pie shell form a high standing rim to retain juice when baking. To prepare sauce: Place blueberries in saucepan and add sugar, water and lemon juice. Stirring gently, heat mixture until it is simmering and sugar is completely dissolved. Cool to lukewarm while preparing cake batter.

To prepare cake: In a mixing bowl cream together butter and sugar until light and

fluffy. Add egg and vanilla, mixing well. Sift together flour, baking powder and salt, add to creamed mixture alternately with milk, beginning and ending with dry ingredients. Pour batter into unbaked pie shell. Gently pour lukewarm blueberry sauce over the top. Bake 35-40 minutes or until cake tests done in a 375 degree oven. To serve, cut in wedges and top with scoops of vanilla ice cream.

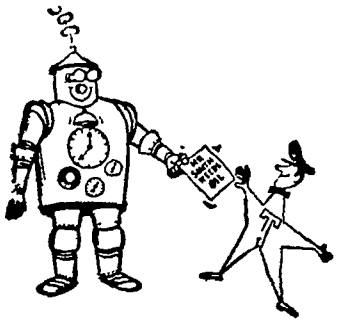
