 At the August 3 horse sale 247 head brought steady prices with killers higher.  
 Riding horses were \$300-335; driving horses brood \$100-245, and killers were 7½ cents a pound. Pony mares were \$40-125 and geldings 125.  
 The 403 hogs at the August 5 auction were sold at \$12.00-13.00.

**WEEKLY REVIEW**  
**Cattle — Receipts** for four days 23,800 as compared with 22,300 last week and 800 a year ago. Twelve markets supply 200,700 as compared with 199,700 a week ago and 188,700 a year ago. Slaughter steers 25-50 higher. Heifers mostly steady. Cows 25 lower and bulls fully steady. In the carlot dressed beef trade, and heifer beef steady to 10c higher, cow beef steady.  
 Primary factor in this week's upturn on slaughter steers was a stronger dressed beef trade as receipts both locally and the twelve markets were unchanged from last week. With this upturn, steers locally are at their highest level since last November.  
**Slaughter steers:** At market, three loads Prime 12-13.
