22 Entertain Husbands**

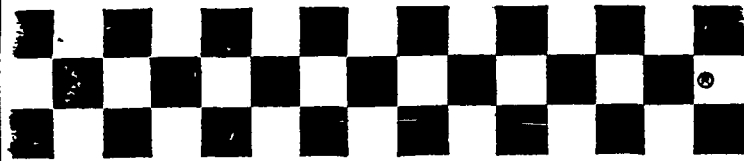

COOL TOMATOES

Tomatoes ripen best in temperatures from 55 to 65 degrees, says J. O. Dutt, extension vegetable gardening specialist at The Pennsylvania State University. That may explain why that red color takes so long coming after the green fruit is full grown on hot summer days. Watering to cool tomato plants during hot periods may hurry ripening of the fruit.

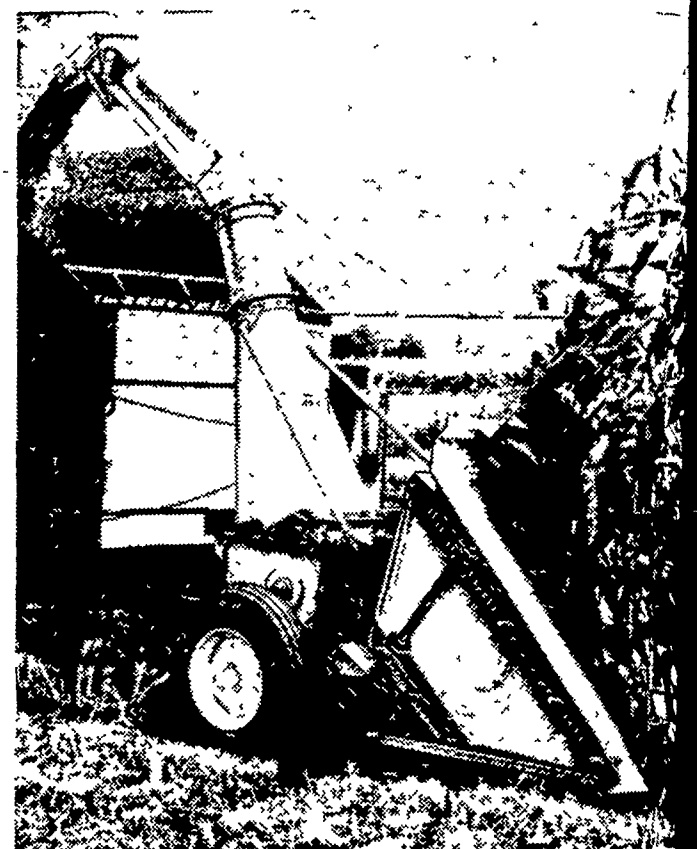
