1/4 cup sliced black olives  
1 tablespoon lemon juice  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce — Dash Tabasco

Cook macaroni until tender drain and rinse in cool water. While macaroni is cooking, cook peas according to package directions. Stir gelatin into 1/4 cup milk. Let soak 5 minutes. Scald remaining 3/4 cup milk and add to gelatin mixture, stirring until gelatin is dissolved. Blend into mayonnaise or salad dressing. Chill gelatin mixture until it is the consistency of unbeaten egg white, about 30 minutes. Combine macaroni, peas, cottage cheese, onion, pimiento, black olives, lemon juice, salt, Worcestershire sauce and Tabasco. Chill. Fold gelatin mixture into macaroni mixture. Turn into 2 quart mold and refrigerate until firm, about 2 hours. Remove from mold and serve immediately. 4 to 6 servings.

Any salad that is left over will keep several days if covered and refrigerated. To serve later, mix the salad with chopped cooked shrimp or tuna or chicken and accompany with little sandwiches, fruit and milk for lunch.
