correctly interpret the symptoms of plant food deficiency in the field, due to other environmental factors constantly affecting the plants. Prolonged periods of adverse weather, insects and diseases may cause symptoms very similar to plant food deficiencies, but where there is a question concerning the deficiencies, chemical tests can be made for calcium, nitrogen, phosphate and potash — the four elements most likely to be deficient. Correction of these deficiencies can be made by applying the amounts of liming and fertilizer materials recommended by soil technicians on the basis of these tests.
