Some of the farmers I talked with practiced soil conservation, some did not, and some had part of their farms under conservation. Could the differences in crop appearance be accounted for by differences in management, or was it area that made the difference?

Most of those who were practicing contour farming, and in some cases terracing, were reluctant to say that this accounted for the relatively good condition of their crops. Two farmers pointed out that the effects of scattered showers could greatly effect yields even on neighboring farms.
