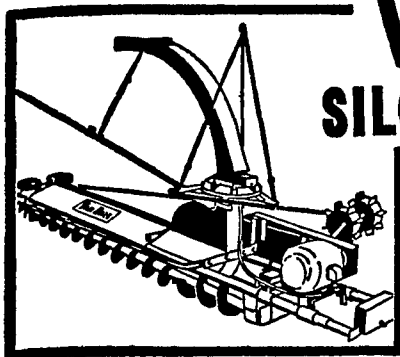


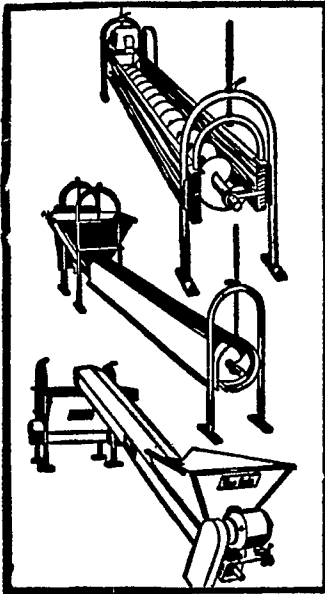

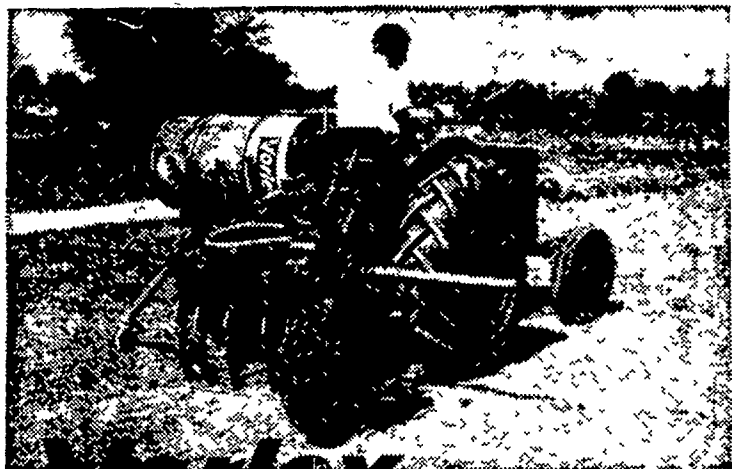

## Packers Say No To The NFO

The current livestock withholding action of the National Farmers Organization is having virtually no effect on the nation's meat supply, an official of the American Meat Institute reported Sunday (Sept 27) at the opening of the AMI's 59th Annual Meeting at the Palmer House.

J. Russell Ives, AMI director of marketing, said that the NFO was misleading farmers with claims that meat packing firms have signed contracts for livestock.

"We know of no single instance of a packing firm which has signed with the NFO," Ives said.

"Meat packers not only feel that the proposed NFO contract is unsound economically but also that they are legally precluded from entering into such a price-fixing arrangement.

"It is unfortunate that farmers are still being misled into a belief that meat packers are signing these contracts."

Ives said that current meat production is well above that

immediately preceding the start of the holding action.

"The NFO leadership is misinforming its members by statements that the withholding action is effective, that meat supplies are declining and that packers are shifting livestock from market to market in order to falsify market receipts," Ives said.

"The error and the absurdity of such statements are clearly revealed by the weekly meat production figures of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Total meat production in Federally-inspected plants for the week ended Sept 19 was reported at 532 million pounds, 26 million pounds above the total production of 506 million pounds during the week of Aug. 15 just before the holding action was started.

"The meat industry deplores the violence that has accompanied this senseless withholding campaign," Ives declared.

The AMI is the major trade association for the nation's meat packing industry. Approximately 6,000 meat packers

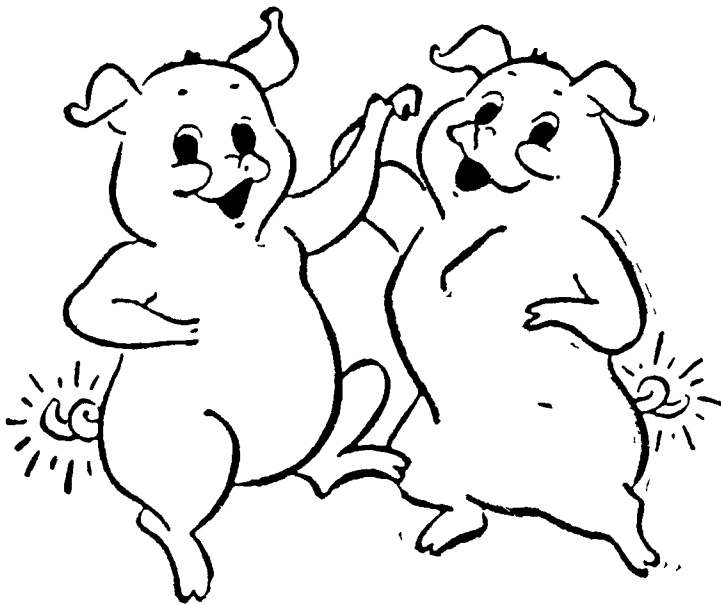
