

Breeders' Award To Wenger Herd

Nine Pennsylvania breeders have qualified for the Progressive Breeders' Award —

the highest recognition attainable by a breeder of Registered Holstein cattle.

The Holstein-Friesian Association of America has accorded this honor to only 586 Holstein breeding establishments, including 62 in Pennsylvania.

To qualify for the Progressive Breeders' Award, a Holstein breeder must meet strict requirements in all phases of dairy cattle breeding and management, including production, type improvement, herd health and the development of homebred animals.

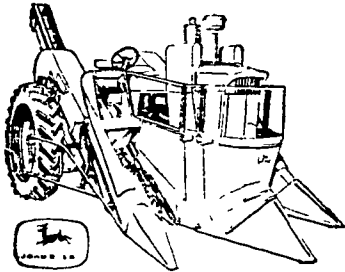
Of the nine qualifying breeders in Pennsylvania, the only one from Lancaster County was the Arthur D. and Mary

K. Wenger farm at Manheim. The Wengers qualified for the third time.

A certificate of this award has been sent to these breeders by the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, national organization of the Holstein breed representing over 42,000 members.

At meetings of Holstein breeders from their areas, bronze plaques signifying the award will be presented to those qualifying for the first time and bronze year plates will be presented to those breeders whose herds have qualified previously to be added to the bronze plaques awarded to them when their herds first achieved the honor.
