

Horses Will Be Shown At H'bg.

For the first time in its 8-year history, the Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition, Nov. 9-14 in the State Farm Show Building, will include horses in the competitive classes, along with beef cattle, swine and sheep.

Harold R. McCulloch, manager, said the horses will be purebred Arabians, all of them breeding stock. Nineteen classes, including champions, will be sponsored by the Pennsylvania Arabian Horse Association, with six additional futurity classes under the sponsorship of the Arabian Horse Association of the East.

Mrs. Charles P. McCreary, Fairview, Erie county, said the Pennsylvania association, of which she is president, will

have approximately 100 head. Mrs. Herbert Stuart, Mt. Holly, N. J., futurity secretary for the eastern group, indicated that colts and fillies to be entered in the futurity classes, may bring the total horse entries to near 150.

Dr. Thomas L. Merritt and Jesse Darlington, both of the Pennsylvania State University, will be superintendent and assistant, respectively, for the Arabian horse division.

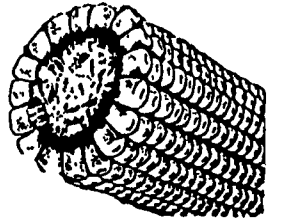
The horses will be judged at 9 a.m. the opening day, Monday, November 9, in the large arena. They will appear again in demonstrations Monday and Tuesday nights as part of the entertainment program.

In addition to the Arabians, 250 horses will appear in the annual Pennsylvania 4-H Horse Show all day Friday and Saturday morning. Still other horses will figure in the exposition as part of the World Championship Rodeo that has been booked for five performances, Wednesday night through Saturday night with a matinee Saturday afternoon.

State Agriculture Secretary Leland H. Bull pointed out that while all of the horses will be of the pleasure type, many of them serve a double role on the farm where frequently they perform light work and find saddle use for business. He said the exposition will be free and open to the public.

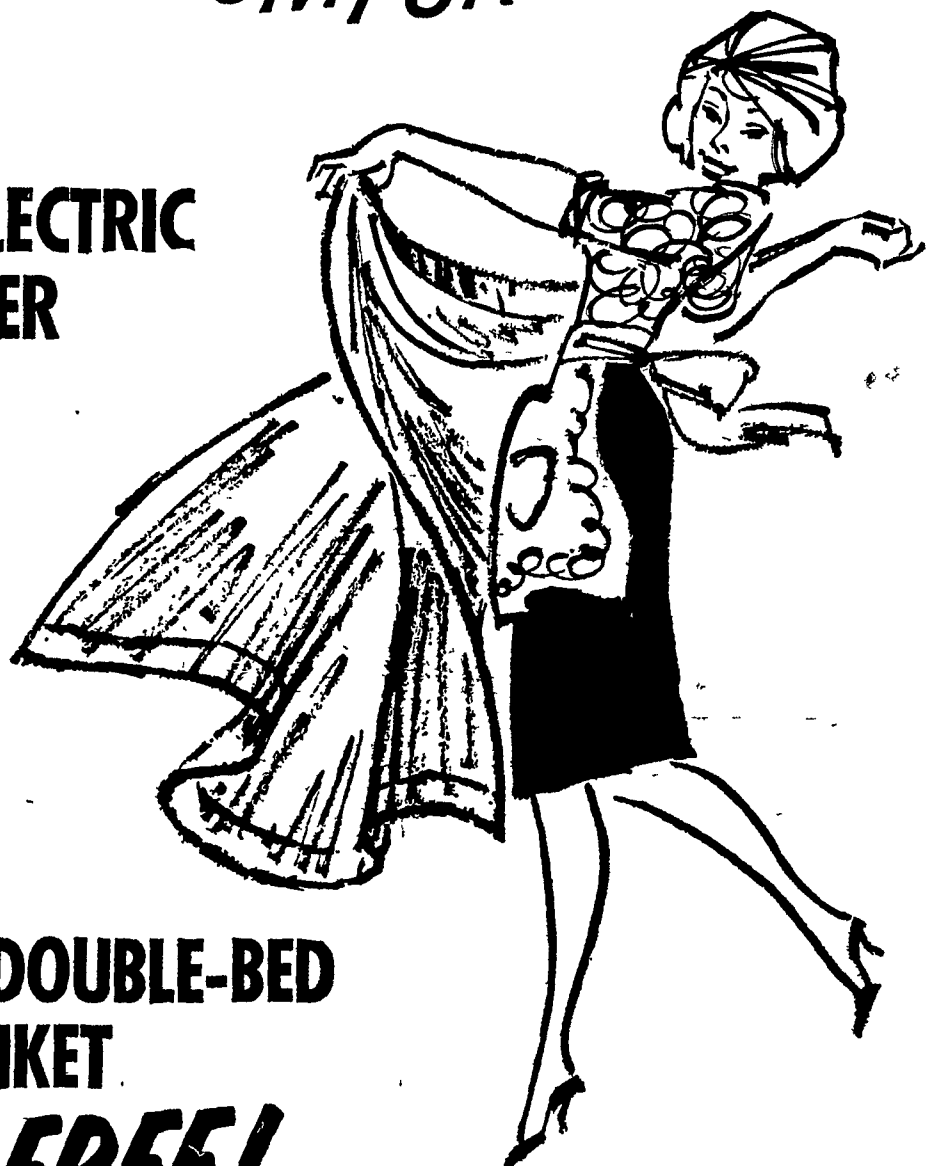
