the breeders and the audience to explain why they rated their selections as they did.

At 2 p.m. the "Show" will move to the Lampeter Fairgrounds, Lampeter, where certain techniques will be demonstrated to the public. These techniques will include electronic estimating of backfat and loineye using a "sonar-ray"; estimation of backfat using a probe; using a carcass to explain how the hogs are judged for a carcass show;

finally, cutting a carcass into the various retail cuts that the housewife purchases.

From 5-7 p.m., a pork barbecue will be served. Tickets must be obtained in advance from a member of the Lancaster County Swine Producers Ass'n. (John Henkel - Willow Glen Farm - Strasburg R1; James Z. Martin - Quarryville RD.) Adult tickets are \$1.75.

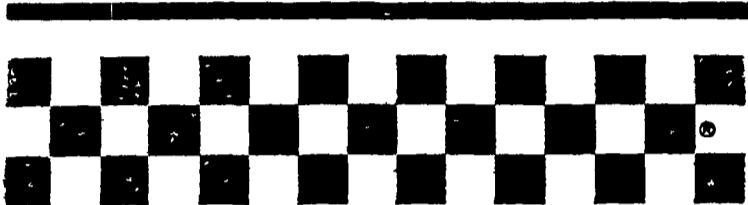

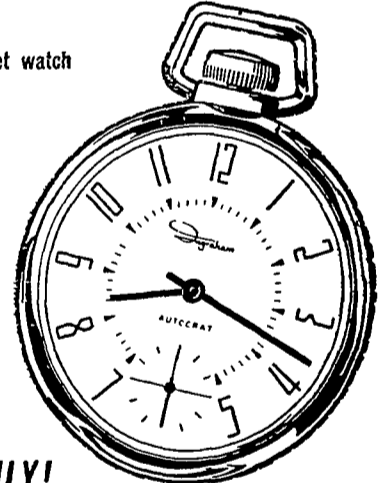
