Compared last Friday, slaughter steers and heifers slow, 25 to mostly 50 lower; cows strong to 1.00 higher in a reaction from last weeks sharp downturn; bulls steady. In the Chicago carlot dressed trade, steer beef steady to 1.00 lower; heifer and cow beef steady to 50 lower.

Slaughter steers: On Monday, 15 loads Prime 1230-1375 lbs 27.00, but at mid-week, around dozen loads 1235-1350
