Pennsylvania livestock breed ers will have 1,462 beef cattle, swine, sheep and horses in the eighth Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition, Novem ber 9 to 14 in the State Farm Show Building

This will be nearly half of the 3,364 total entered from 19 states H R McCulloch, exposition manager, said the Pennsylvania entities will come from 219 farms in 41 countres.

Ohio will be in second place among the states with 690 animals entered by 76 breeders Other states with entries are Vermont. Massachusetts, Connecticut New York, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland, Viiginia, South Carolina, Georgia, Kentucky, Indiana, Michi gan, Illirois, Missouri and Oklahoma

Centre will lead Pennsylvania counties with 229 animals in 21 entries, including one of 113 animals from the Pennsylvania State University. This, will be the largest single entry in the entire show.




