(Continued from Page 1) among dealers in their seasonal purchases, thus stabilizing prices; taking a stand to keep the present Pennsylvania Milk Control law and maintain retail prices.

The speaker touched briefly on the changing buyer patterns, citing the example of Martin-Century Farms selling out to Lehigh Valley Cooperative with the ensuing shuffling of milk markets for many dairymen. He mentioned the pesticide problem and exploratory meetings that had been

held with Food and Drug Administration. The State Department of Agriculture will soon be stopping bulk trucks and taking samples of the milk to be sure there is no illegal residue present, Honan said. (See article "USDA Announces Milk Indemnity Program" elsewhere in this issue.)
