

**FREY IVANHOE DAUGHTER COMPLETES OUTSTANDING RECORD**



FULTONWAY IVANHOE RAE, OWNED BY J. MOWERY FREY, JR., has placed 1st for fat and milk in Pa., and 1st for fat and 6th for milk in the U. S. in 305 days, 2X milking. Rae is a daughter of the gold medal sire, Osborndale Ivanhoe. On 365-day basis, 2X, she ranked 1st for fat and milk in Pa., and 1st for fat and 4th for milk in the U.S. In 305 days she had 25,560 lbs. milk, and 1,138 lbs. fat. Her 365-day record was 28,530 lbs. milk, and 1,290 lbs. fat.

**Certificate Needed To Sell Christmas Trees**

The State Agriculture Department warned persons planning to sell Christmas trees that a dealer's certificate is required for the sale of living trees or any living plant — those with roots in pots, balls, baskets or in burlap.

The restriction comes under the Plant Pest Act and is designed to assure buyers healthy plants that are free of pests and disease, according to State Agriculture Secretary Leland H Bull.

Certificates may be obtained, he said, at no cost from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Plant Industry. Those obtaining certificates, however, are required by law to handle only certified stock.

Henry F. Nixon, director of the Bureau of Plant Industry, explained that there is a double risk in buying uncertified plants that may be infested

with insects or disease. Not only may the plant itself die, but it could infest healthy trees or plants nearby, he pointed out.

Nixon added that requirements for a certificate apply to all persons dealing in live

trees, whether they sell on consignment or buy direct for retail sale. No certificate is required for sale of cut trees, Nixon said.

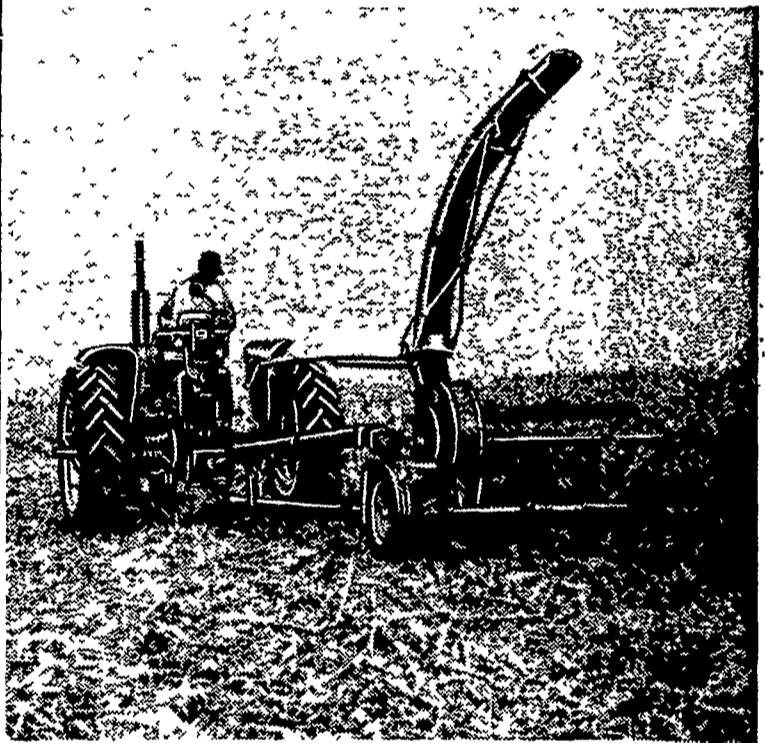
