

**NEXT YEAR'S STATE  
PLOWING CONTEST TO BE  
HELD AT HERSHEY**

Next year's Pennsylvania State Plowing Contest will be held August 28 at Hershey, Jack R Grey announced recently, following a meeting of the State Plowing Committee at which he was elected president

Grey, deputy state secretary of agriculture, succeeds Charles M Wolgemuth, Hershey, head of the 1964 meet that was held at Fort McCoid in Franklin county

Elected with Grey were Charles B Slaton, vice president, and Charles F. Lebo, secretary, both Harrisburg, and N. H Wooding, University Park, as treasurer.

In selecting the August 28 plowing date the committee endorsed a proposal by the Pennsylvania Grassland Council. The council will conduct a 1965 statewide Forage Progress Day at Hershey on August 27.

Having the two events at the same location and on successive days, it was explained, will suit the convenience of commercial exhibitors and other persons interested in both affairs.

The forage and plowing programs will be held on the 10,000 acre M S. Hershey Estate Farms, and at a location that has marked the site of other similar activities in recent years.

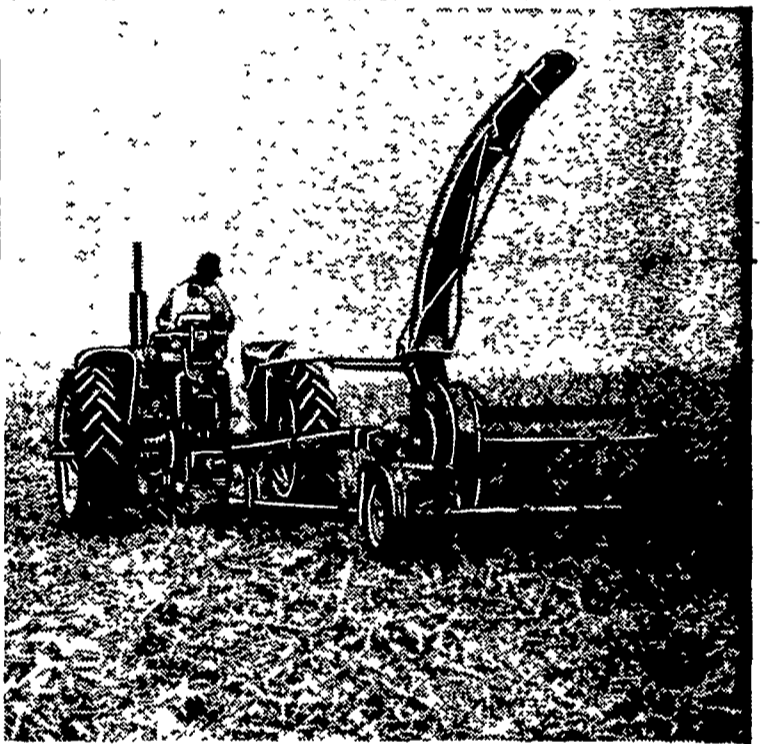
