WEEKLY REVIEW

**CATTLE** — Receipts for the four days 26,500 compared 27,900 last week and 26,900 a year ago. Twelve market supply 242,200 compared with 201,700 last week and 216,000 year ago. Slaughter steers 25-50 higher, heifer steady. Cows 25 higher. Bulls steady in the carlot dressed beef trade at Chicago, steer and heifer beef steady to 50 lower. Cow beef 50-1.00 higher.

Slaughter steers opened steady but worked higher Tuesday and Wednesday despite a lower dressed trade and continued moderate receipts. Supply 70-75 percent slaughter steers, 15 percent heifers, balance cows. Bulk steers 1400 lbs. down with the average weight estimated to be nearly the same as last
