HAMBURGERS WILL SOON CONTAIN MORE MEAT, LESS FAT

Hamburgers may have more meat, less fat than in the past, according to revised regulations issued by the State Agriculture Department for production and sale of sausage meat products in Pennsylvania.

The new rules provide that hamburger, and similar products of any other name, may contain no more than 30 per cent total fat. In the past, as much as 50 per cent fat was permissible, according to Delmar K. Myers, director of the department's Bureau of Foods and Chemistry.

The rules also ban, as they did in the past, the use of preservatives, coloring, meat by-products and filler, such as bread or crackers.

Ground or chopped beef from a specific portion of the carcass may contain no added fat and total fat may not exceed 20 per cent, Myers said. The label also must identify the specific cut, such as "ground round," or "ground chuck."

Another section of the revised rules pertains to smoked products, such as ham, pork and bacon. The finished product may not exceed the weight of the fresh uncured meat, according to a new regulation that limits or controls the use of moisture in the curing process, Myers said.

Smoked meat that exceeds the original weight because of added moisture must be labeled "Water Added," Myers explained. The extra weight, however, may not exceed 10 per cent of the weight of the fresh, uncured cut, he added.

SOLID FURNITURE

Solid furniture is just what the term implies—the same wood is used throughout, at least on all exposed parts, explain Penn State extension home management specialists. Solid wood may be carved, turned or grooved. If it becomes scratched or chipped, it may be refinished. Solid wood, however, has a tendency to warp and crack.
