Compared with last Friday, slaughter steers 50-75 lower, heifers 50 lower, both steers and heifers average Good and below continued hardest to move. Cows strong to fully 25 higher; bulls 50 lower. In the Chicago carlot meat trade, steer and heifer beef 1.00-1.50 lower, Utility and Commercial cow beef Steady to 50 lower but Canner and Cutter 50 to 1.00 higher.

Slaughter steers and heifers worked lower again this week in response to further price declines for wholesale beef. Two straight weeks of record
