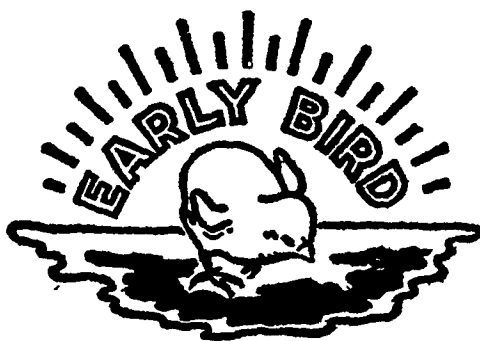

was included on the last area
recertification test or was milk
ring tested within six (6)
months of the show. These
animals must be brucellosis
blood tested within 120 days
of the show.

C All cattle officially bru-
cellosis vaccinated and under
30 months of age may be ex-
hibited without a blood test
provided they originate in
herds designated as "A" or
"B"

D Progeny under six (6)
months of age from herds de-
signed as "A" or "B" may
be shown without a blood test,
provided the dam is identified

HEMORRHAGIC- SEPTICEMIA

REQUIREMENTS

All cattle shall be protected
against hemorrhagic-septice-
mia by either or both of the
following

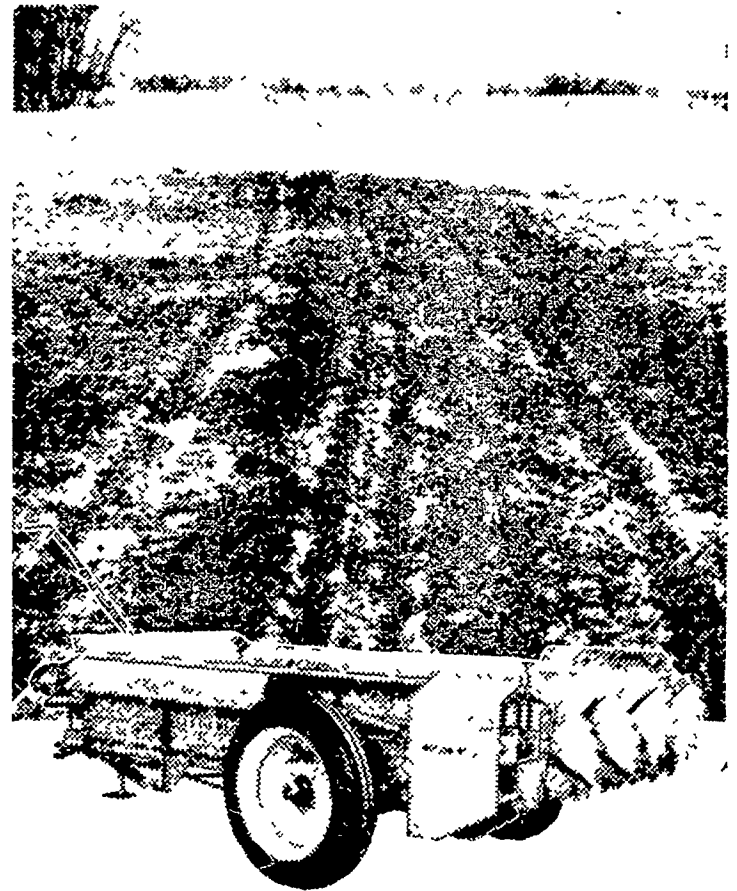
(a) Two inoculations of
hemorrhagic-septicemia bacter-
in administered not less than
5 days apart with the second
inoculation given not less than
two weeks prior to the en-
tries' arrival at the show.

(b) A prophylactic dose of
hemorrhagic-septicemia hyper-
immune-serum administered
within 3 days of the entries'
arrival at the show

A report of hemorrhagic-
septicemia vaccination writ-
ten by an accredited veteri-
narian shall accompany entries
to the show or sale

For the protection of the
herds to which show animals
return, such animals should
be isolated for at least 30
days. All animals except of-
ficially vaccinated under 30
months of age should be iso-
lated until they have safely
passed a negative blood test at
least 30 days following their
introduction into a herd
