what lumpy batter makes light pancakes. For each cake, pour about 1/4 cup batter onto hot, lightly greased

griddle. Bake to a golden brown.

For filling, pan-fry chipped beef in butter. Stir in 1 cup of the sour cream. Place about 1 tablespoon filling on each pancake; roll up. Arrange in

two 1 1/2 -quart greased casseroles or one 9x13-inch greased baking pan. Spread remaining sour cream on top. Bake in preheated slow oven (325 degrees) about 5 minutes or until heated. Makes 8 servings.

NOTE: This dish can be prepared in advance, refrigerated, then baked about 15 minutes before serving piping hot.

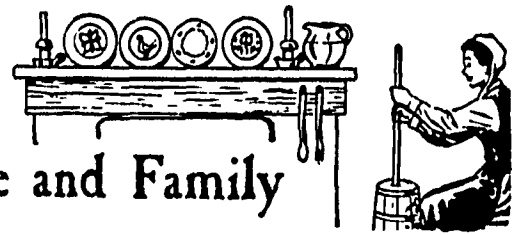
FULTON GRANGE #66 MEETS

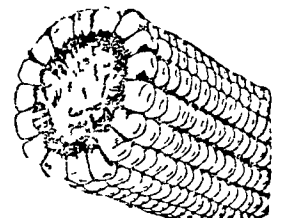

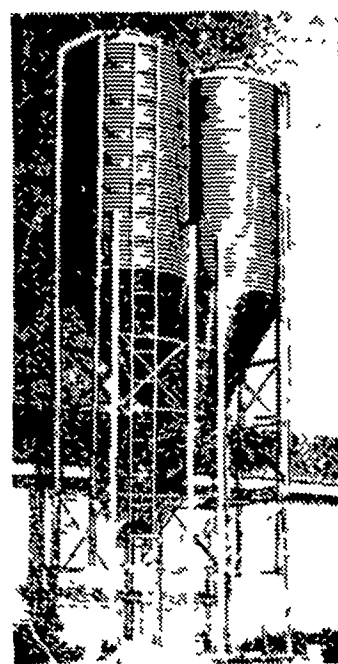
