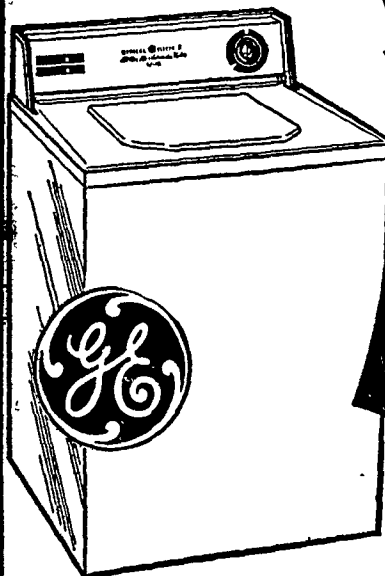

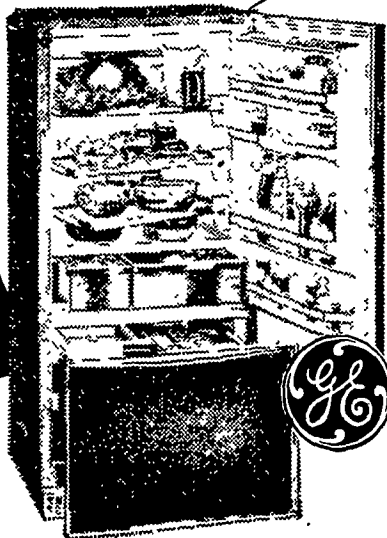

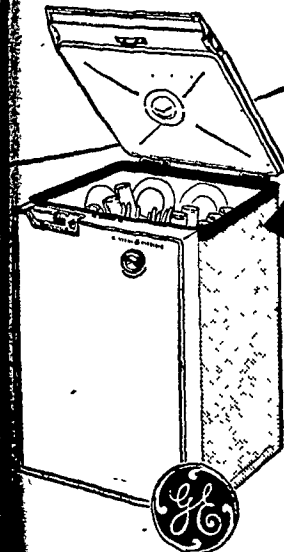

17.1; 773,400 head, including 229,600 head purchased of 319,200 head offered at Eastern Poultry Growers Exchange Thursday. Eighteen percent of the broilers sold at 16.0-16.4.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending Jan. 22, 1965 was 3.5, up two points from the preceding week. The mash cost averaged \$103.68, and the average broiler price was 17.90 cents per pound.

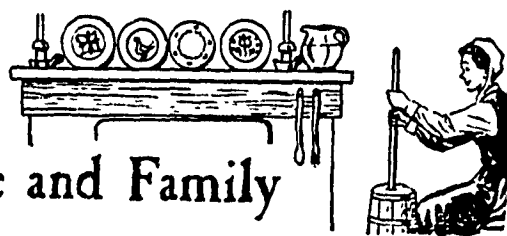
At the horse sale on Jan. 25 the trend was slow to barely steady, with 245 head offered.

Mules sold singly brought 125-210; in pairs, 240-480. Riding horses brought 110-250; driving horses, 110-210; killers, 5½-6 cents per pound. Pony mares brought 30-85, and geldings, 25-85.

Hogs sold steady while sows were \$1 higher at the sale on Jan. 25; 328 head were offered. Market hogs retailed at 19-20.50; wholesale (U.S. 1-3), 18-18.75; heavyweights, 17.50-18. Sows brought 12.50-16.50.

Calf receipts totaled 100 head at the Jan. 25 sale, and sold for \$1 higher. Choice and Prime brought 37-41.50; Good and Low Choice, 33-36; Standard 29.50-32.50; Common, 15-25.

Do You Know

Well-chosen snacks can contribute to dental health and good nutrition. For the best dental health, it's recommended that you cut down on eating sweets between meals.

Pasteurized-process cheese is a blend of one or more types of cheese, as described on the label. The processing gives a cheese that melts readily and smoothly. Cheese spreads and cheese foods are softer forms of process cheese, and often have added nonfat dry milk and flavor ingredients. Such as olives or pimientos.

Some Hints to Help Improve Ironing Skills

Always be sure clothes are clean before you iron them. Wash anything slightly soiled before ironing it.

Iron with a clean iron. If starch sticks to the soleplate, let the iron cool, then wipe it with a cloth dipped in soap or detergent suds. Rinse and wipe dry before heating.

Wash ironing board cover as needed to remove starch, lint, and dye transferred from dark clothes. Wash a new cover before using it to remove

sizing . . . sizing scorches at low heat.

Cover an ironing board when not in use to help keep the cover clean. You can use a fitted washable plastic cover or a paper or plastic garment bag.

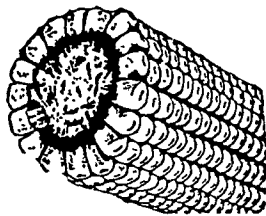
Fold dampened clothes lightly instead of rolling them . . . fewer wrinkles will get set into the damp fabric, and less ironing will be needed. If you put dampened garments into a plastic bag, the moisture will be distributed more evenly. Plastic bags are handy to keep non colorfast articles separate from others while they're damp.
