neighborhood of 22,000 acres. This came as somewhat of a surprise since it had been hint-

ed that the allotment would be nearer 27,000 acres. The USDA felt, however, that with supplies at near-record levels a higher quota would have been unrealistic. If more than one-third of the county's growers vote against quotas at the coming referendum, the whole question goes out the window anyway. Lancaster County growers have never approved tobacco quotas, and the local opinion is that that situation will not change this year.

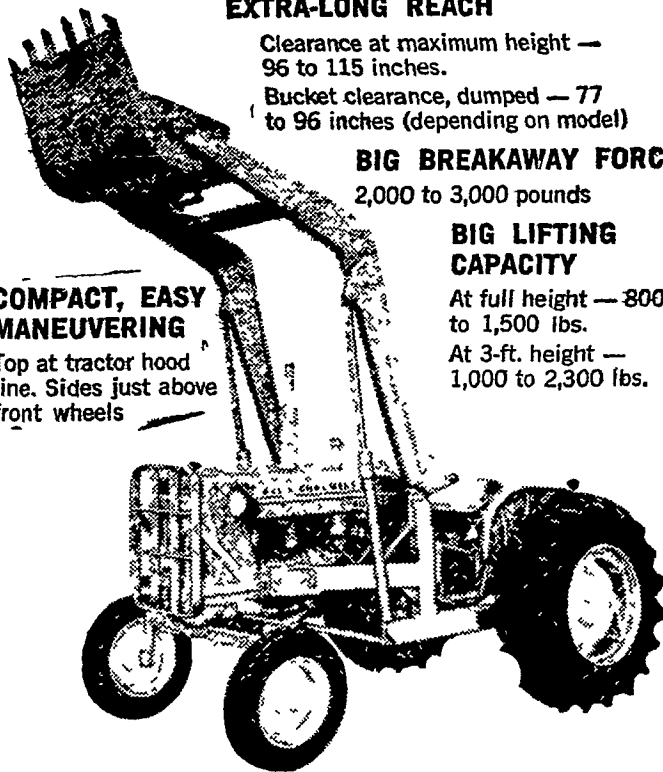
