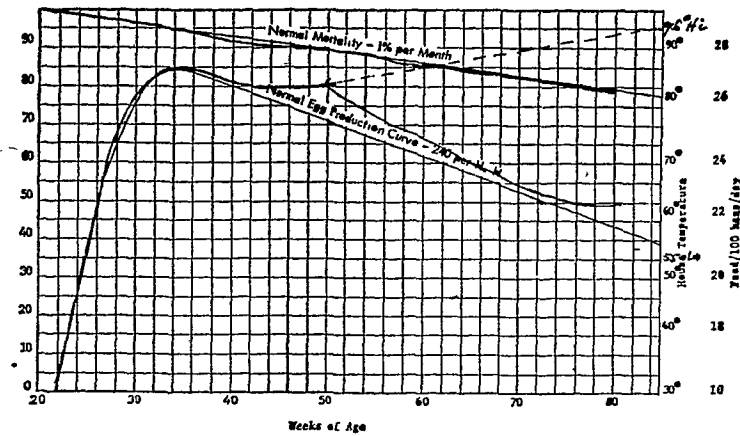

A resolution opposing the federal government's proposed cut-back in conservation funds was drafted by Amos Funk, chairman, and unanimously approved by the directors. The resolution will be sent to Congressman Dague and to Senators Scott and Clark prior to Congressional action on the cut-back proposal.

Plans for the Annual Banquet on March 9 at Solanco High School were further crystallized by the directors, including a list of award recipients.
