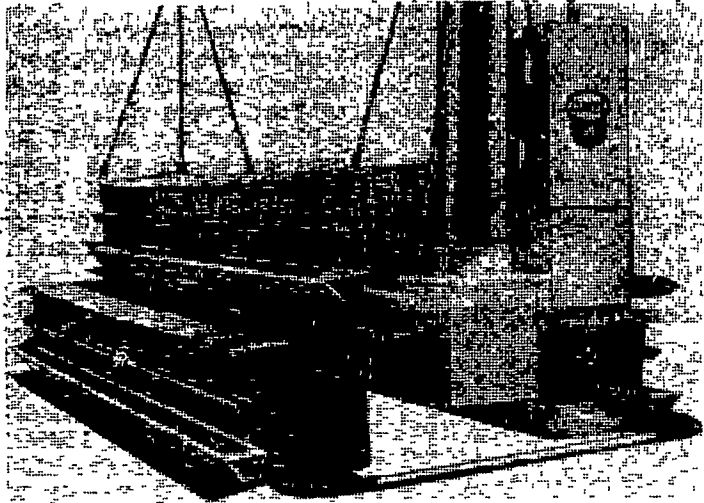

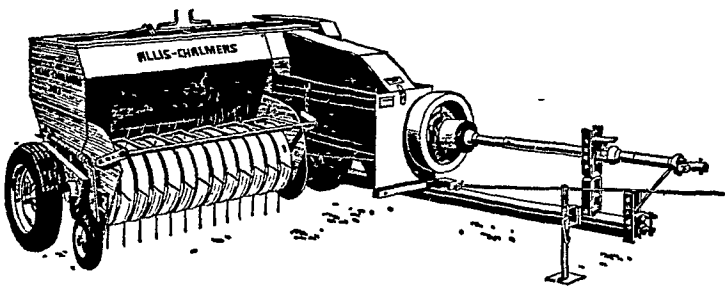

tan area of Lancaster. Some 150 business, industrial and professional men are joining forces with farmers in helping to make the campaign a success. The total objective of the drive is to raise a mini-

num of \$275,000 for the purpose of erecting an agricultural center and to provide a scholarship fund for deserving students majoring in agricultural studies.

In a joint appeal to the more than 500 Farm Division solicitors, Levi H. Brubaker, Chairman of the unit and General Co-Chairman of the campaign, said: "We are pleased by the initial progress of the campaign and the generous support received from many individuals and county businesses. However, we have a great many calls remaining to be made and reported on the Campaign Headquarters.

We urge every volunteer to complete his calls within the next week, if possible, and to report promptly to his District Chairman. With the next stage of the drive just getting under way, the Farm Gifts Division should finish its part of the task without delay."

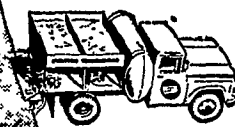
