PENB Hopes To Offset Low Egg **Prices By Action**

An intensive program to counteract depressed egg prices has been launched by the Poultry and Egg National Board, with special appeals to retailers and school lunch administrators, a recent PENB release states.

Major food chains are being urged to take advantage of the current low egg plices by pushing eggs and products which tie in with eggs. The PENB folder, "It's Egg Time," containing eight easy-to-use egg recipes, has been made available to food stores at a special low price, for insertion in egg cartons and for distribution in stores A special mailing to the chains reminds them to take advantage of the meatless meal promo-

regulations were amended in March 1964 to require livestock buyers to promptly pay sellers for purchased livestock. However, the regulation did not require prompt p'ayment to agents who purchase livestock with their own funds for other persons.


Division officials said that, in some cases, agents have not been reimbursed for purchases made with their own funds, or their principals have deliberately been slow in reimbursing their agents in order to obtain involuntary extensions of credit.

The new regulation, therefore, will guide the industry in correcting such an unfair and deceptive practice which violates the P&S Act, USDA

said.


