resignation effective April 1. He plans to disperse his dairy herd on March 19. President Dum asked for nominations from the floor to fill this unexpired term of one year. However, it was decided by the directors that it might be more appropriate if Hackman and Clarence Crider, tester, discussed the matter jointly and arrived at a suitable replacement.

Considerable discussion centered around the question of distributing the use of forage samplers to farmers through the association's supervisors. The forage samplers, which are augers designed to sample baled hay, were originally distributed through the Extension Service. It was felt by Penn State that better farmer-availability could be achieved if each of the state's milk testers were to carry this equipment on his regular rounds. The forage testing kits will sell for \$5 each, and the sampling tool will require

only a deposit for its use. It was finally decided that these kits and the samplers would be distributed by the supervisors on a strictly voluntary basis.

The question of a pay raise for the DHIA testers was discussed. It was reported that their last raise was in 1960, and that many of them felt their costs had risen appreciably since that time. President Dum felt that there was not enough information presently available for a sound decision to be made. He named a committee headed by Dr. Victor Conger and consisting of Robert Bieneman, Jacob House, and Curtis Akers to investigate the matter and present the facts to the board at the next quarterly meeting.

Among other questions it was decided to continue the directors' meetings on a quarterly basis rather than more frequently, and repay the Holstein Association the \$400 they had advanced for the purchase of SNF (solids-not-fat) testing equipment.
