### Penn State Extends Its Agribusiness Program

Agricultural business training, leading to an associate degree from The Pennsylvania State University, will be taught this Fall at two Commonwealth Campuses, at Altoona and Umontown.

The two-year program was opened last Fall at the Altoona campus and will be extended in September to the newly opened Fayette Campus at Umontown, announces Jerome K. Pasto, Associate Director of Resident Education for the College of Agriculture.

Dr Pasto reports a variety of employers have shown considerable interest in the two-year "agribusiness" program. Graduates will work with companies processing and marketing farm products and with businesses providing supplies and services to farmers. The training will include accounting, management, marketing, crop and livestock production, and other skills.

### Beef Consumption Up; Pork and Lamb, Down

More folks are eating red meat in the United States, according to the National Live Stock Producer. Consumption of red meat products came to 174 pounds per person in 1964 — the highest volume in history.

Beef consumption had a new record high of 100 pounds per person, reflecting the 13% increase of animals slaughtered. Pork consumption of 64 pounds was down slightly.

Total meat and poultry consumed was 212 pounds — a gain of about 2% over 1963. Poultry reached a record 38 pounds per capita.

Compared with other countries, the United States ranks fifth in red meat consumption. New Zealand, Australia, Argentina, and Uruguay all top the United States by more than 30 pounds per capita.
