known to occur in 85 counties of the three states and a costly State Federal effort is being made to keep it from spreading to new areas

The latest known areas of infestation are scarcely 50 miles west of Pennsylvania, according to Henry F. Nixon, director of the Bureau of Plant Industry State Agriculture Department

He said five men armed with sweep nets — they look like oversized butterfly nets — have started work under USDA supervision in grain fields along Pennsylvania's western border. They will pay particular attention to fields bordering on wooded areas, and to sections where large quantities of haymuck have been imported from Ohio, Indiana and Michigan, Nixon added.

The insect is quite small, about a quarter of an inch long and not much wider than an average straight pin. It has a tiny bright red head and iridescent blue wings.

Facts About Prunes

Small prunes, sometimes called breakfast prunes, range from 67 to 85 in a pound, making 10 to 12 servings of 7 prunes each.

Medium prunes yield 53 to 67 prunes per pound or 9 to 11 servings of 6 prunes each.

Large prunes range from 43 to 53 in a pound, making 8 to 10 servings of 5 prunes each.

Extra large prunes yield 36 to 43 prunes per pound or 9 or 10 servings of 4 prunes each.

Prunes can fit into almost any course of the meal from appetizer to dessert. They are a good nibble food for between-meal snacks, or a lunch-box dessert treat — just sweet and chewy enough to satisfy any leftover hunger pangs.

A prune cake is delicious and stewed prunes are a good breakfast food.


