

Channel 8; plans were discussed for a director's tour of the county for the county commissioners in September.

Steven Mace of the State Game Commission announced that a special antlerless deer season held in several southeastern Pennsylvania Counties was a success. He reported that the 369 deer killed during the special season was in line with the program to keep the deer population in balance.

Wayne Maresch, county conservationist, announced that his department had exceeded its goal on combined footage of cropland and diversion

terraces. He also submitted the applications of three new cooperators Leon Z. Martin, Stevens R1; Arnold J. Rawson, 313 Copples Lane, Wallingford; Richard Bard, Conestoga R2. These were unanimously approved by the directors present.

Maresch announced he is still in the process of bringing the Soil Conservation Service cooperator file up-to-date. He submitted 22 names of former cooperators for cancellation who were either deceased or out of farming. These cancellations were approved by the directors. Chairman Amos Funk an-

nounced that a tentative date, July 19, had been set for a joint meeting with the Lancaster County Planning Commission to clarify the position of agriculture in county development plans.
