 Calf receipts totaled 9 head and sold steady at the May 31 sale Choice brought 32-32.50, Good and Low Choice, 30-32, Standard, 28-30 Common, 22-27.

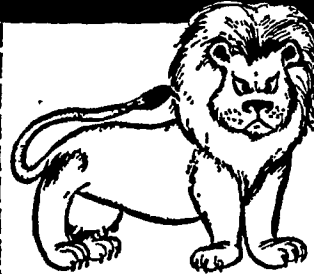
