Delmarva market broiler and fryer live prices declined sharply—nearly ½ cent. Demand was only fair for moderate auction offerings.

Some processors reporting curtailed activity due to small sizes, largely due to reduced growth rate in hot weather.

Estimated slaughter for Friday and Saturday 770,000 head compared to 905,000 head last weekend.

In the 24-hour period preceding market close on Fri-

day, broiler and fryer live prices ranged from 16.3-17.5 cents per pound on sales of 848,500 head.
