Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) 25 minutes or until done. Cut into squares and serve immediately.

- TROPICAL PIE SHELL cups ready-to-eat high
- protein cereal cup soft butter or margarine

Crush high protein cereal into fine crumbs. Blend butter, sugar and cereal crumbs; mix well. Stir in coconut Press evenly and firmly such as coconut, lemon, orange or pineapple.

Ladies, Have You Heard?...

Some Tips For Care Of Outdoor Furniture A brisk scrubbing with hot soap and detergent suds will clean the wood, canvas, plastic, and cord webbing on outdoor fuiniture. Always 11nse well with clear water and

wipe off excess water. around sides and bottom of Before cleaning porch, garden, and patio 9-inch pie pan. Chill. Fill lights, disconnect the cords, then wash with suitable cream filling, shelds with hot soap or detergent suds Wipe such as coconut. lemon. or safety's sake, dry the bulbs before connecting the colds.

You can clean metal fixtures, such as garden lamps and metal chair frames, with suds Use a brush to sciub all surfaces, then linse with clear water and wipe with a clean dry cloth.

You can save yourself trouble and enjoy your terrace furniture right after a heavy downpour if you protect it with plastic covers or throws. To keep off dew, put the covers on at night.



Terrycloth shpcovers should have elastic edging to hold them snugly in place. Be-

sides the comfortable absombency of terrycloth, these slipcovers are machine-washable at the first sign of soil.
