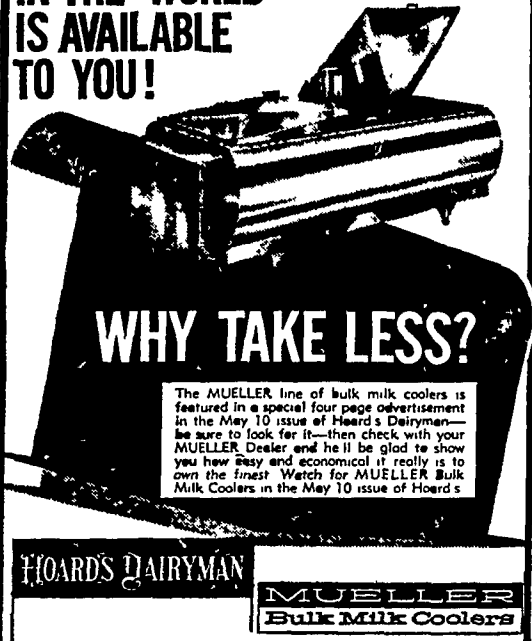

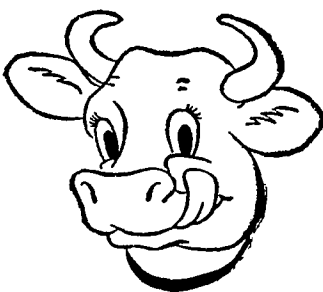

fifty quarts of homemade ice cream which was served as part of the refreshments.

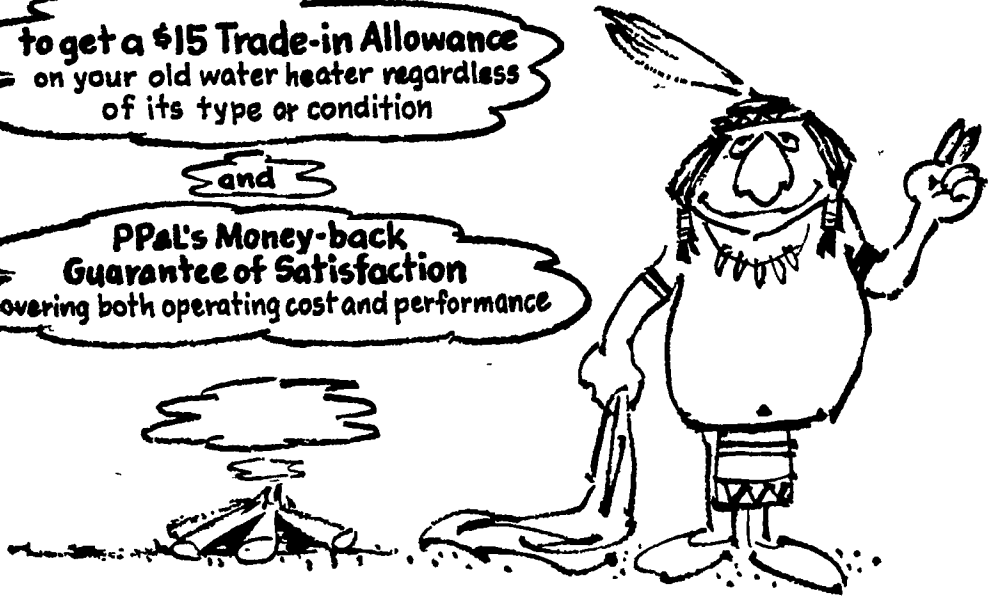
