## Delmarva

Delmarva market broiler and fryer live prices declined more than 1/4 cent on Friday with only fair demand for heavy auction offerings.

Ready-to-cook demand ranged from fair to good with most plants running near capacity. Deliveries to Philadelphia area were curtailed by the continuing truck strike. Delivered prices were also off 1/4 cent.

Estimated slaughter for this weekend was 919,000 head, compared to 882,000 head last weekend.

In the 24-hours preceding market close on Friday, broiler and fryer live prices ranged from 140-165 cents per pound on sales of 1,156,700 head.

Cows generally 1.00 lower and bulls mostly 50 lower. In the carlot dressed meat trade, steer and heifer beef steady to 1.50 lower, most decline on Choice steer carcasses. Cow beef 1.00-2.00 lower.

Receipts 28,200 compared with 22,100 last week and 26,200 a year ago. Twelve market totals 186,500 compared with 164,200 a week ago and 205,700 a year ago.

Slaughter steers: Late, nine loads of Prime 1200-1350 lbs 29.00. On Monday, twelve loads Prime 30.00-30.25, High Choice and Prime 1150-1375 lbs 28.00-30.00, closing 28.00-28.75. On Monday, a load of High Choice and Prime 28.75, Choice 1000-1350 lbs 26.25-28.75, late 26.25-28.00. Loadlots Mixed Good and Choice closed 25.50-26.25, Good 23.50-25.50, Standard and Low Good 21.00-24.00.

Slaughter heifers: Late sales High Choice and Prime 900-1050 lbs. 26.50-27.15 with early sales 27.50-28.00, four loads at 28.00 on Monday and Tuesday Choice 850-1050 lbs 25.00-27.25, late mostly 26.50 down, Choice 750-850 lbs 24.50-26.00. Mixed Good and Choice 750-1000 lbs. 24.00-25.00, Good 21.50-24.50, Standard and Low Good 20.00-22.00.

Cows: Utility and Commercial 14.50-16.75, closing largely 15.50 down, Canner and Cutter 12.00-15.50, mostly 12.00-14.75 late.

Bulls: Utility and Commercial 17.00-20.00, mostly 19.50 down at the close.
