

Good Yield On Grain Crops Led By Bonus Barley

An exceptional barley crop is being harvested in southern parts of the Commonwealth with some fields producing as much as 80 bushels to the acre, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The average yield for the entire state last year was 45 bushels per acre, a record high.

Above average yields of wheat are expected, but recent wind and rain storms in some sections caused some lodging. Oats are filling out.



From the base of the corn plant. Some varieties develop more than others. Removing suckers seldom increases sweet corn yields and may decrease yields if the suckers are well along. Although straw is short, showers and thunderstorms

are removed late in the season. Suckering removes the foliage which manufactures food.

To Know Your Pesticides
Never use insecticide formulations designed for plants, soil, or buildings as a treatment on livestock. Be sure to use for livestock pest control only those insecticides and formulations designed specifically for livestock or poultry use. Although the same chemicals may be used in preparations for the treatment of both plants and animals, the concentration and formulation can be very different, and the difference can mean a sick animal. Pesticide poisoning symptoms can mask or be confused with other serious disorders, such as rabies, encephalitis, making diagnosis difficult. In the case of pesticide poisoning, residues may build up in the animal tissues and make the animal unfit for slaughter, even after apparent recovery, in dairy cattle especially. Dairy men should be particularly careful about using the proper pesticides on their cattle, in their barns and for their forage crops.

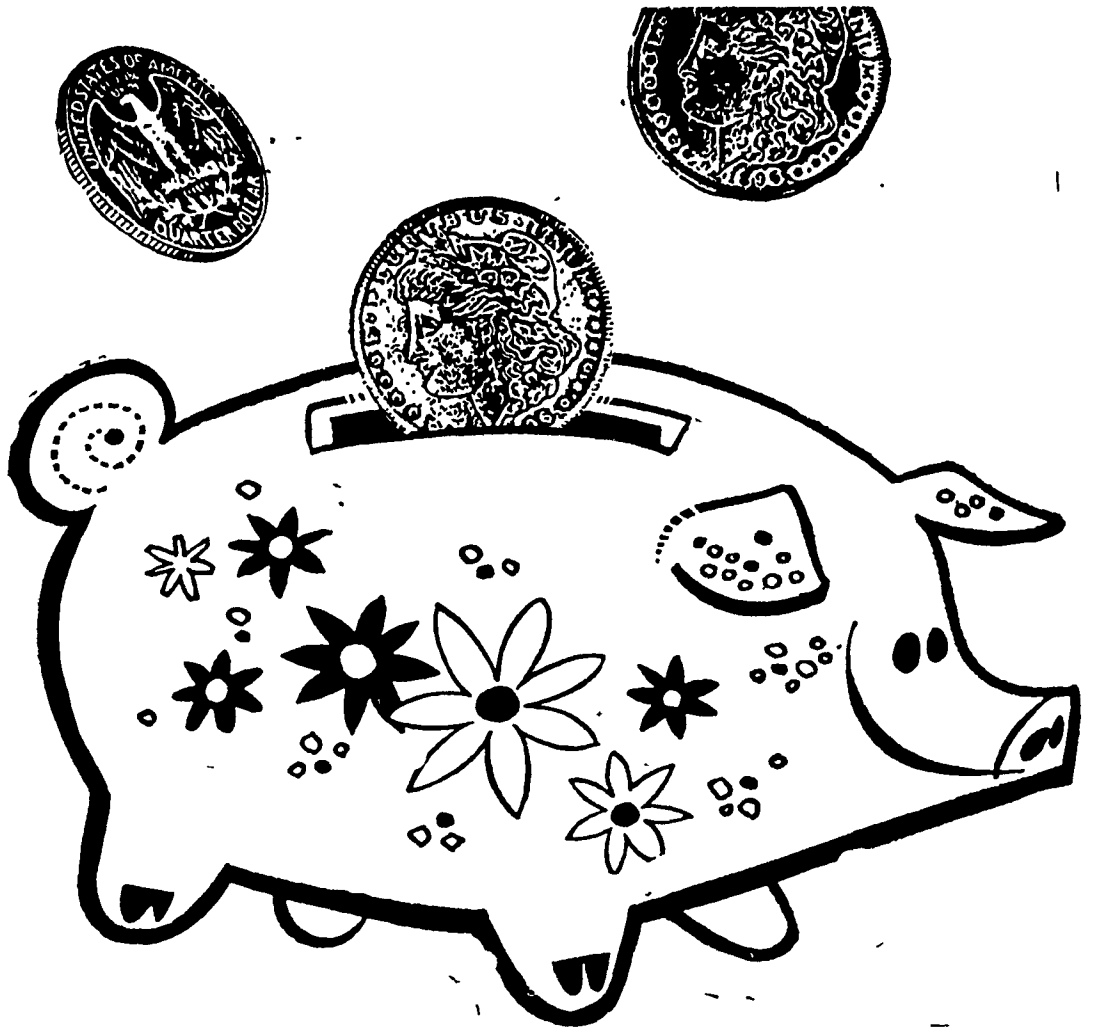
