store it in the original container in the freezer or freezing compartment of the refrigerator. For short time storage in the refrigerator without low temperature freezing (zero degrees or lower), transfer ice cream to a dry freezing tray, cover with foil or plastic film and set control to low.

Worth Knowing Anytime

It's easy to keep wood salad bowls or other wood pieces as beautiful as the day you got them. Right after use, wipe off each piece with a soft cloth or sponge and warm suds. Rinse with cold water and dry thoroughly — never soak woodenware in water. Keep woodenware away from heat and store it in a dry place.

Use heavy cotton terry beach towels to make covers for children's pillows, chairs, or bunk beds. They're easy to wash, and towels come in a wide range of bright colors and gay prints.

Because leftover gravy and broth are highly perishable, cover and store in the refrigerator right after a meal. Use these foods within one or two days.
