## LIVE HENS

Prices on light type hens unchanged to 1/4c higher. Demand good for limited offerings. Trading on heavy type hens light. Buying interest dull, offerings limited. Increased live offerings from New England points noted. Occasional loads of 6-7# fowl sold at 12-12 1/2c plant. Prices paid at farms: Light type hens 7-8 1/4, mostly 7 1/2-8; Heavy type hens 15 1/2-16c. **TURKEYS** — Trading confined to heavy type hens. Offerings fully adequate for the fair demand. Few lots of 26-30 lb. toms sold at 21-22c.

## Eastern Shore Exchange

### WEEKLY SUMMARY

Broilers and fryers live prices on the Eastern Shore Exchange averaged 16.21 cents per pound this week, down 37 cent from last week's average. The high and low in the range of prices paid both occurred on Tuesday with a 15.3 low and a 17.5 cent high.

Sales for the week totaled 1,675,600 head, a decrease of slightly more than one-quarter million head from last week's total.

## Delmarva

August 20, 1965

Delmarva live broiler and fryer prices continued to hold steady with good demand for moderate auction offerings. Live supplies of 3 1/2 lb. birds, and up, were in short supply while adequate on other sizes.

Ready-to-cook demand spotty, ranging slow to fair with some light feature activity next week in N.Y. and New England areas. Prices are trending lower and very competitive.

Estimated slaughter for this weekend is 852,000 head compared to 922,000 head last weekend.

In the 24 hours preceding market close on Friday, broilers and fryers live prices ranged from 15 7/16.7 cents per lb on sales of 1,162,600 head.

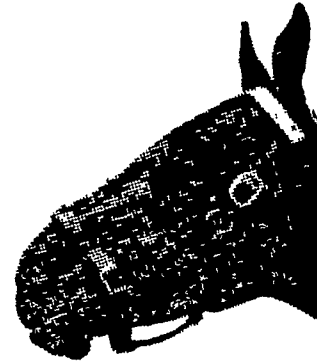
