

### Brucellosis-Free Swine Herd List Issued By USDA

The U. S. Department of Agriculture has issued an update listing of all swine producers with Validated Brucellosis-Free Herds. Brucellosis is the most deadly disease of swine and one that can be transmitted from man to man as undulant fever. This national listing, prepared by USDA's Agricultural Research Service, gives the producer's name and location and the breed of swine qualified Validated Brucellosis Free. To be validated, all breeding animals in the herd 6 months of age or older must give negative in two consecutive brucellosis tests. The

tests are made 30 to 90 days apart. Validation is effective for 12 months and applies to all offspring of the breeding animals tested. Herds may be re-validated for an additional 12-month period upon completion of an annual negative brucellosis herd test. Animals from a validated herd may be moved across state lines without individual blood tests. Progress in the Federal-State program to eradicate swine brucellosis can be measured by the increase in the number of validated herds. The first national listing in 1953 contained only 937 herds. During the next 12 months the number increased to 1,409. The 1965 listing totals 1,950 validated herds — more than double the number reported 2 years ago.

### Wheat Allotments Will Be Distributed Next Week By ASCS Office

The notice of 1966 wheat allotments will be mailed to all farmers on Sept. 15th. The allotments may be lower than 1965, as the 1966 national allotment is less than this year. By law, the national allotment is established at an amount which will be expected to produce the total quantity of wheat required to meet anticipated needs. The total wheat needed for 1966 is about the same as needed for 1965, but with the general increase in yields, fewer acres are required.

ASC does not expect to have a fall signup for the 1966 wheat program. Instead, the signup for Wheat and Feed Grain Programs will probably be held at the same time, according to Miss Dorothy Neel, office manager.

Additional 1966 program information is dependent upon action by Congress, and will be distributed as soon as available, Miss Neel reports.

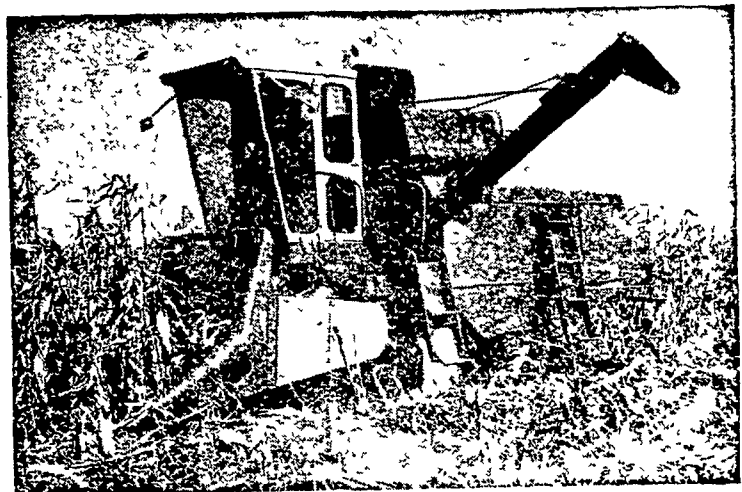
