Public Hearing Set For September 30 On **New Seed Regulations**

The State Agriculture Department will hold a public hearing Thursday, Sept. 30 on proposed, rules and regulations to be effective under the new Pennsylvania Seed Act of 1965.

The hearing will be held at 9:30 a.m. in Room 103 of the Agriculture Building on North Cameron Street, opposite the Farm Show Arena.

Henry F. Nixon, director of the department's Bureau of Plant Industry, said the principal changes involve labeling and selling of seed and the inclusion of flower seed among those covered by the new law.
