parsley and pepper; cook 2 minutes. Push to side of pan. Add eggs, and cook, stirring gently, until just set. Stir in pork mixture, then noodles and soy sauce. Turn into casserole and serve immediately.

**Oriental Noodle Soup** would be good served with sesame bread sticks, butter or margarine, almond cookies, fresh fruits and milk.

- ORIENTAL NOODLE SOUP**
- 8 ounces thin noodles
  - 6 cups water
  - 1 can (4 oz.) mushroom stems and pieces
  - 2 teaspoons soy sauce
  - 2 chicken bouillon cubes
  - 1/2 cup thinly sliced green onions
  - 1 cup thinly sliced cooked pork, cut in 1/2x1/8 inch strips

Cook noodles in boiling water until tender, yet firm, 2 to 4 minutes; drain and re-serve. In large saucepan combine 6 cups water, mushrooms, soy sauce and bouillon cubes. Cook until mixture boils. Reduce heat and simmer 10 minutes. Add onions; remove from heat. To serve,

**COCOA KISSES**

- 2 egg whites
  - 1/2 teaspoon vanilla flavoring
  - 3/4 cup sugar
  - 3 cups cocoa sweetened toasted rice cereal
  - 1/2 cup chopped nutmeats
  - 1 cup shredded coconut
- Beat egg whites and vanilla until foamy. Add sugar gradually, beating until stiff peaks form. Fold in cereal, nutmeats and coconut. Drop by tablespoonfuls onto well-greased baking sheets. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 10 minutes. Remove at once from baking sheets. Makes about 4 1/2 dozen cookies.

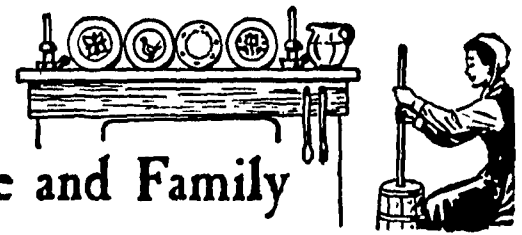

Elizabethtown R1, and Stanley G. Greiner, Manheim R4, placed second. The Zook herd with 13.0 registered and grade Holstein cows averaged 1596 lbs. of milk, 56 lbs. of butterfat with a 3.5% test. The Aungst herd with 31.3 registered Holstein cows averaged 1527 lbs. of milk, 56 lbs. of butterfat with a 3.7% test. The Greiner herd with 19.0 registered Holstein cows averaged 1484 lbs. of milk, 56 lb. of butterfat with a 3.8% test.

**Worth Noting About Coffeemakers**  
Coffeemakers are becoming more functional and more attractive, and are appearing in new designs and finishes. Prices of coffeemakers vary with the metal used, type and size of heating element, and cup capacity.

Some coffeemakers with top capacity of 8 or 10 cups will be equally successful in making half that quantity. Read the manufacturer's directions about the variation in the number of cups.

The exterior finish of a coffeemaker may be chrome, stainless steel, brass, copper, and the popular high-styled colors or even silver-plated models.

Handles are easy to grasp immersed in water. Read the instructions that come with the model coffeemaker you buy for cleaning and care, which are not damaged when

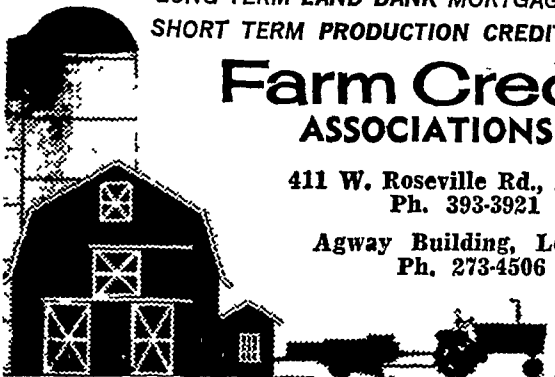
