

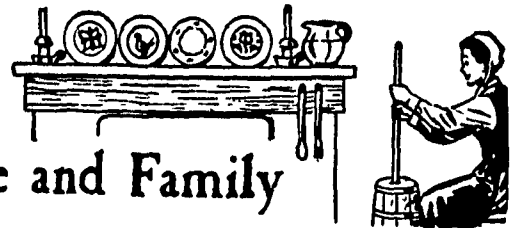

1/2 cup mayonnaise, mustard  
1/2 cup horse-radish.  
**GREEN BEAN MARINADE**  
1 package frozen green  
beans

1/4 teaspoon salt  
1/4 cup water  
1/2 cup French dressing  
1/2 cup pimiento, cut into  
thin strips  
1 small onion, finely  
chopped  
1/8 teaspoon pepper  
2 eggs, hard cooked  
Cook frozen beans in water  
for about 15 minutes or until  
just tender; drain thoroughly.  
While hot, combine with  
French dressing, pimiento,  
onion and pepper. Chill thor-  
oughly. Serve on crisp let-  
tuce, garnished with slices of  
hard-cooked eggs. Serves 6.

**GREEN BEANS EN  
CASSEROLE**  
2 packages frozen green  
beans  
1/4 cup salad oil  
2 medium onions

Few sprigs parsley  
1 clove garlic  
1/4 cup cottage cheese  
1/2 cup grated Cheddar  
cheese  
4 eggs, slightly beaten  
1 teaspoon salt  
Dash pepper  
1 cup soft bread crumbs  
Cook frozen beans according  
to package directions; drain.  
Heat salad oil in saucepan;  
stir in chopped onions and  
cook until tender. Remove  
from heat; stir in chopped  
parsley, crushed garlic, cot-  
tage cheese, Cheddar cheese,  
eggs, salt, pepper and bread  
crumbs; mix well. In greased  
medium-sized casserole, ar-  
range a layer of beans; cover  
with half the cheese mixture,  
another layer of beans and a  
final layer of the cheese mix-  
ture. Bake in 350 degree oven  
for about 20 minutes until  
golden. Makes 6 servings.

**Ladies, Have You Heard? . . .**

**Tips On Thawing Frozen Fruits**  
You get the best color and flavor from  
frozen fruit if you leave it in the sealed con-  
tainer to thaw.

Serve the fruit as soon as thawed — a  
few crystals in the fruit improve the tex-  
ture for eating raw.

You can thaw frozen fruit in the pack-  
age in the refrigerator, at room temperature,  
or in a pan of cool water. Turn the package  
several times for more even thawing.

Allow six to eight hours on a refrigera-  
tor shelf for thawing a one-pound package of  
fruit packed in syrup. For the same size  
package, allow two to four hours for thawing  
at room temperature and a half to one hour  
for thawing in a pan of cool water.

Fruit packed with dry sug-  
ar thaws slightly faster than  
that packed in sirup. Both  
sugar and sirup packs thaw  
faster than unsweetened  
packs. Thaw only as much  
fruit as you need at one time.  
But if there is leftover  
thawed fruit, cook it. The  
cooked fruit will keep for a  
few days in the refrigerator.

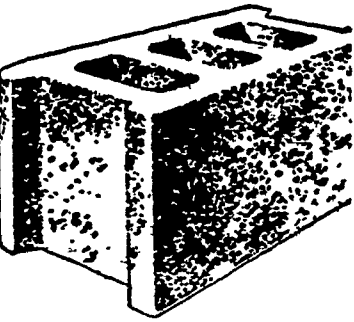

ditions.

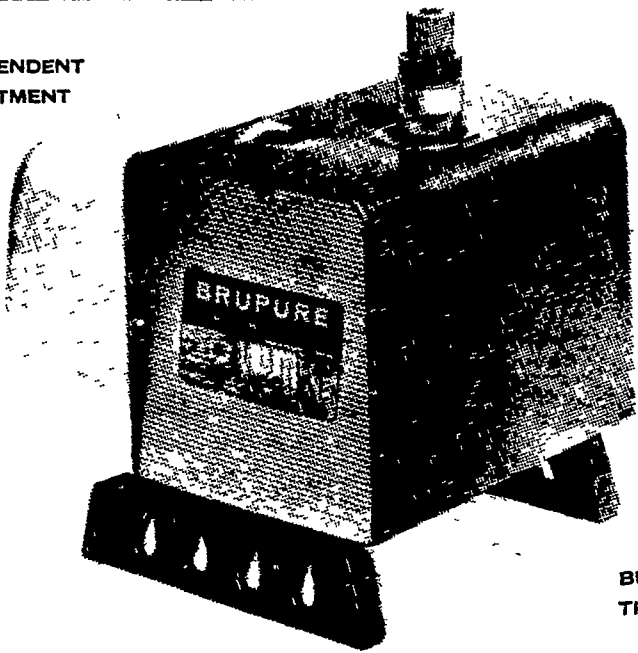
Each dealer operates a wide
