## "Make It With Wool" Contest Set For Nov.

Pennsylvania young women and girls soon will be competing in a "Make It With Wool" contest that will be serving an added purpose as a distaff aid to agriculture, according to State Agriculture Secretary Leland H. Bull

Only American loomed knitted or felted, 100 percent wool may be used in fashioning garments that are to be judged in district, state and national competition

Secretary Bull said the state's sheepmen produce nearly 1,500,000 pounds of wool annually, and that the contest will help to stimulate this phase of the Commonwealth farm program

Closing date for entering the competition is Nov. 6. Twelve district roundups will be held Nov. 12-20, and the state finals, Nov. 26-27 in Harrisburg. Mrs. Dick M. Coons, York R3, is state director

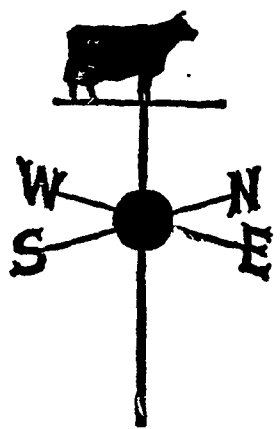

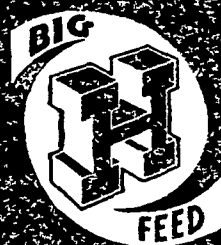
