USDA Yearbook Of Agriculture Now Available

How the U S Department of Agriculture's services are woven into the fabric of American life is reflected in Consumers All, the 1965 Yearbook of Agriculture which packs into 496 pages thousands of how-to-do-it facts for everyday living

Subjects covered include buying and using food, clothing, household furnishings, and equipment, managing money; caring for yards, gardens, and houses; improving communities, using leisure time, and staying healthy.

"This book presents practical results of the Department's efforts to make the lives of people healthier, happier, more fulfilling," Secretary of Agriculture Orville L. Freeman points out in a foreword. He notes that two in every three dollars of USDA expenditures "are spent for services of primary benefit to all of us as consumers"

"Though a primary objective of the Department is service to U. S. farmers and ranchers," Secretary Freeman states, "the real beneficiary of agricultural productivity and abundance has been, is now, and will continue to be the American consumer"

The Yearbooks are distributed mainly by members of Congress, each of whom has a number for free distribution. Consumers All can be bought at \$2.75 from the Superintendent of Documents, the Government Printing Office, Washington, D C 20402. The Agriculture Department has no copies for general distribution

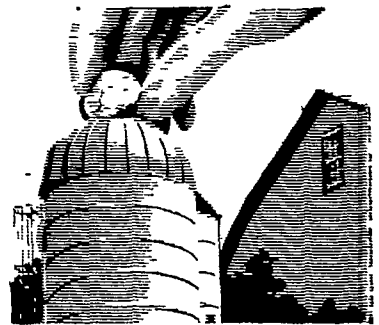
