

**Potato Import Rules Revised By USDA**

The U. S. Department of Agriculture has announced revisions in grade, size, quality and maturity regulations for potato imports, effective October 1, 1965, as follows:

Round white varieties will be limited to U. S. No. 2 or better grade, 1 1/2 inches minimum diameter. The U. S. No. 2 grade cannot be more than "moderately skinned" and all other grades cannot be more than "slightly skinned."

Round red varieties must meet the same grade, and maturity requirements as round white imports, except they must be at least 2 1/4 inches in diameter, and the maturity requirements will be effective only through Oct. 16.

Long Varieties will have to be U. S. No. 2 or better grade, 2 inches minimum diameter or 4 ounces minimum weight, not more than "slightly skinned," and at least 90 percent "fairly clean," except White Rose variety potatoes may be imported if not more than "moderately skinned."

Size B round red and long varieties can be imported if

U. S. No. 1 or better grade, and meet the maturity and cleanliness regulations for respective varieties.

C&MS officials said the above import requirements will continue through June 30, 1966, unless changes in domestic regulations require revisions.

The Agricultural Marketing

Agreement Act requires potato imports to meet the same requirements as domestic potato shipments regulated under a Federal marketing order. Whenever two or more marketing orders regulating potatoes produced in different areas of the United States are in effect at the same time, the act requires that imports must comply with the regulations on the domestic crop in most direct competition.
