duction is just 40 pounds more than the 1961 national record made by Breezewood Champion Barbara, owned by Gebke Brothers of Vienna, Ohio. "Barbara's" 12-month lactation stood at 30,827 lbs of milk and 1,300 lbs of butterfat, she retains butterfat production leadership in her class.

Meanwhile, her sister was bred and developed in the Mowry Farms herd at Roaring Spring. She was sired by Gay View, sired by a Gold Medal recorded bull. Her dam is Mowry Leader Crystal. "Esther's" fat production is a second place record in the 325-day 2X period, three-year-old division, displacing the former butterfat production level of Harriet Pebe Arab, owned by Howard Sisson of Sierburne, New York.

In Pennsylvania, "Esther" becomes the first place milk and butterfat production leader for her class. The former milk leader in the Keystone State was Erway Rag Apple Kathleen, owned by Cleon C. Buck and Son of Ulysses Her record was 25,360 lbs of milk and 920 lbs of butterfat.

Area Guernseys Complete Tests

Several area Guernsey breeders had cows recently completing official DHIR records according to the American Guernsey Cattle Club.

Three registered cows in the herd of L. A. and R. P. Wimer, Willow Street R1, scored as follows: Natural Grove Lola L. B. a Sr 9-year-old produced 12,600 lbs of milk and 615 lbs of fat in 325 days; a Sr 7-year-old Beatrice Perfect Anne had 12,490 of milk and 571 lbs of fat in 299 days; Penn Del Reliable Milky Way, a Sr 4-year-old made 12,000 lbs of milk and 622 of butterfat in 295 days.

Rutter Bros., York had two cows registered. They were Esie of Red Ridge Farm, a Sr 11-year-old, producing 11,650 lbs. milk and 545 lbs of fat in 289 days; and Rutter Bros. Superior Kate, a Jr. 3-year-old, with a milk record of 12,030 lbs., and 585 of butterfat, in 287 days.

Also in York, the herd of Valley Acres, Inc. had two Sr 2-year-old cows completing records; Laurel Cliff Dame

Paul with 11,480 lbs. of milk were for 305 days. He produced 10,980 lbs. milk and 565 lbs of fat; Laurel Cliff S Fanta with 10,620 and Lebanon had two Jr. 2-year-old cows with 305-day records respectively. Both records were for 305 days. He produced 10,500 of milk and 522 lbs. of butterfat.

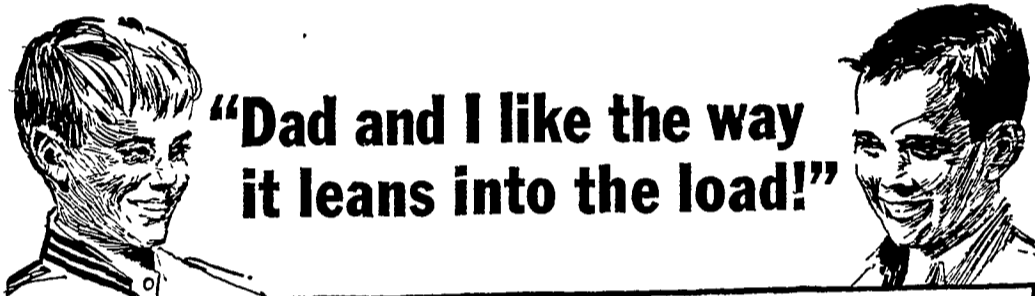

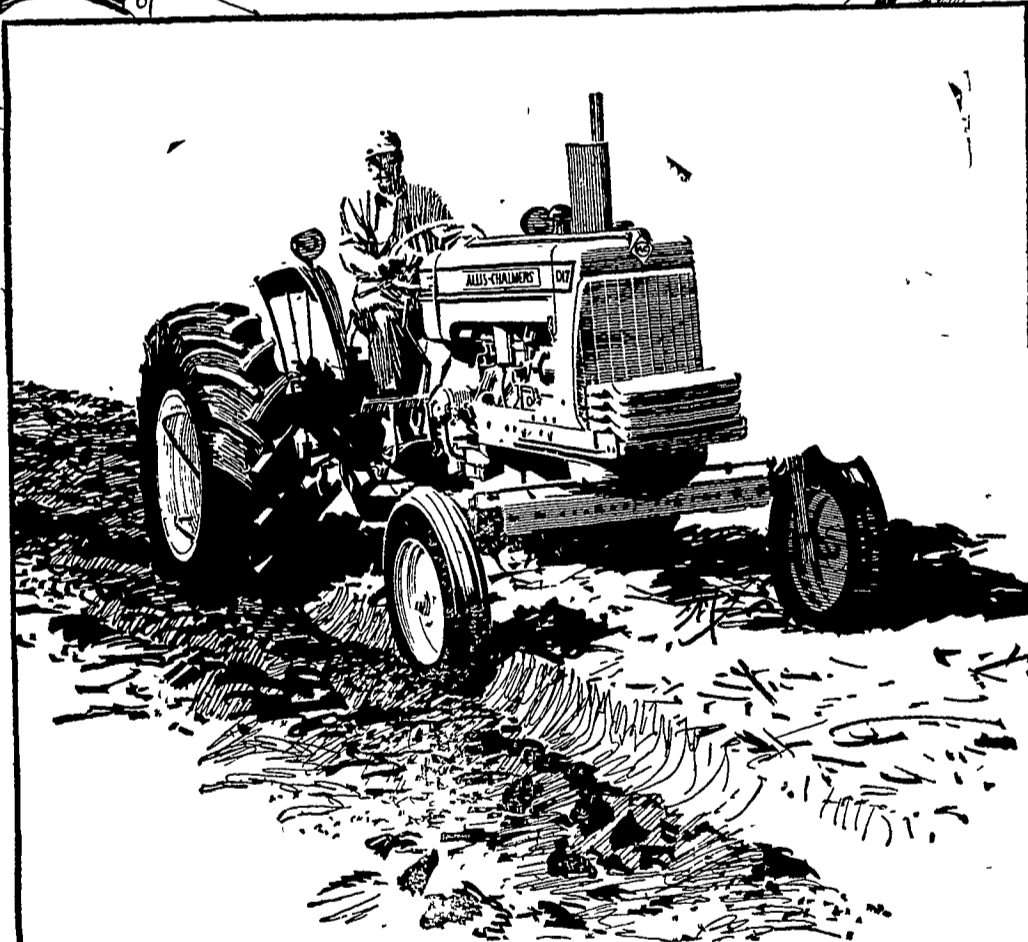
